10/31/2020 Update Pima County Registered Voters And Early Ballots Received-by Age

Included in the release are the number of Active Eligible Voters in Pima County and the number of ballots verified by our office. The numbers shown are broken down by age and percentage returned. All numbers represent a snapshot in time and are constantly changing. The Recorder’s Office is running two shifts in our ballot processing center to meet the high demand.
