As of Friday, August 3, 2018, the Pima County Recorder's Office has mailed out over **287,000** Ballot by Mail ballots to the voters of Pima County. Voters who are members of one of the four recognized political parties: Republican (REP), Democratic (DEM), Green (GRN) or Libertarian (LBT) and on the Permanent Early Voter List (PEVL) or have requested a ballot, have been mailed their ballot. The initial ballot mailing was on Wednesday, August 1, 2018. Voters should be looking out for their GREEN ENVELOPE ballot package in the mail.

By Arizona State Law, Independents (IND) and Party Not Designated (PND) registered voters have the right to select which political party ballot they would like to vote. Of Pima County's 524,464 register voters 160,392 are registered as IND/PND. Currently, only 21,316 or 13% of IND/PND voters have requested a Ballot by Mail in Pima County.

Below is the breakdown of the party ballots sent including the IND/PND breakdowns.

As a reminder, IND/PND voter's registration will not be changed when selecting a political party ballot. These voters will remain in the IND/PND status.
