## LAST DAY TO MAIL YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT COMING UP FOR VOTERS IN THE CATALINA FOOTHILLS SCHOOL DISTRICT, SUNNYSIDE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE PROPOSED TOWN OF VAIL

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind those voters who live in the above school districts or the proposed Vail boundaries who still have a vote-by-mail ballot that they need to mail it by **FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2013** in order to allow enough time for the ballot to reach the Recorder's office by Election Day, November 5, 2013. Vote-by-mail ballots can also be dropped off at any polling location on Election Day or at any of the Recorder's sites listed below:

Those voters who may still have a City of Tucson vote-by-mail ballot can also drop off their City of Tucson vote-by-mail ballot at any of the Recorder Offices listed above on Election Day.
