LAST DAY TO MAIL YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT COMING UP QUICKLY

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind voters that they should mail their vote-by-mail ballots no later than **FRIDAY**, **OCTOBER 31**, **2014**. This will allow enough time for the ballot to reach the Recorder's office by Election Day, November 4, 2014. Vote-by-Mail ballots can also be dropped at any of the Recorder's Office Early Voting Sites, which are open until Friday, October 31, 2014. On Monday, November 3, 2014 and Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2014 vote-by-mail ballots can be dropped off at the following Recorder's Office locations:

115 N Church Ave. in downtown Tucson, Monday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Tuesday 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

6920 E. Broadway Blvd, Suite D on the Eastside, Monday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Tuesday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

6550~S. Country Club Dr. on the Southside, Monday $8:\!00~a.m.$ to $5:\!00~p.m.$, and Tuesday $8:\!00~a.m.$ to $7:\!00~p.m.$

Vote-by-mail ballots can also be dropped off at <u>any</u> polling location on Election Day, November 4, 2014.
