## Record Number of Voters Registered In Pima County! For The 2016-General Election

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez announced today that between August 1, 2016, the cutoff for the Primary Election and October 11, 2016 the cutoff for the General Election, Pima County added <u>34,418 new voters</u> an increase of almost 7% to our voter registration rolls! The tables below show Countywide numbers by political party and are also broken down by Congressional District.
