MAIL IN YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT BY THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2016

Early voting and Vote-by-Mail for Pima County has been underway for almost three weeks. The total number of ballots returned is currently at **216,795**. F. Ann Rodriguez, the Pima County Recorder would like to remind everyone, "The suggested time to mail in your Vote-by-Mail ballot is Thursday, November 3rd."

You have <u>THREE</u> options when returning your Vote-by-Mail ballot:

- 1) **MAIL IT:** We recommend you mail your Vote-by-Mail ballot by Thursday, November 3rd to ensure your ballot reaches our office by Election Day.
- 2) <u>EARLY VOTING:</u> You can drop off your Vote-by-Mail ballot at any of our Early Voting Locations. For a list of Early Voting Site locations and hours visit <u>www.recorder.pima.gov</u> and click on <u>Early Voting Sites</u>. Three Pima County <u>Early Voting Sites</u>, as well as phone lines, will be open on Saturday, November 5, 2016 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- 3) **ELECTION DAY:** Take your Vote-by-Mail ballot to any Pima County polling location on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2016 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7 p.m. and give it to a poll worker.
