Video Shows Ballot By Mail Security

Today the Pima County Recorder's Office released a video showing how the office processes mailed ballots, including signature checking. In this brief video, Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez takes a tour of the process that will be especially informative to voters who may be concerned about the safety and security of mailed ballots. In addition, voters can track their ballot after they mail it in.
