Walk-In Early Voting Sites Open!

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind voters that there are TEN (10) walk-in early voting sites open around Tucson and surrounding areas, including Sahuarita/Green Valley, Ajo, the Tohono O'odham Nation, and the Pascua Yaqui Tribe.

Early voting sites Downtown, on the Eastside, North Side, Mid-Town, South Side and Sahuarita/Green Valley area will be open on Saturday, October 30, 2010.* (*Please see list of early voting sites attached.*) In addition, the early voting site in the main Recorder's office at 115 North Church Avenue will be open Monday, November 1, 2010.* "After that, voters will need to go to their assigned polling location to vote the day of the Election," said Ms. Rodriguez.
