20,000 EARLY BALLOTS STILL OUTSTANDING!!!

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez announced that of over 40,000 early ballots mailed to Pima County voters for the February 5, 2008 Presidential Preference Election, approximately 20,000 have been returned to the Recorder's office.

That means there are still about 20,000 ballots that either were dropped in the mail today, or haven't been mailed yet.

"Voters may drop their early ballots off at either of the two Recorder's offices on Monday or Tuesday," stated Ms. Rodriguez. "Also, on Tuesday, voters may drop them off at any polling place in Pima County. I strongly recommend to voters that if they didn't mail their ballot by Friday, February 1st, they should hand-deliver it to make sure it gets to us in time." Ballots must be in the possession of the Recorder's office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 5, 2008.
