EARLY VOTING FOR NOVEMBER 5, 2013 GENERAL ELECTION NOW IN PROGRESS

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind voters that early voting for the November 5, 2013 General Election is now in progress for the Altar Valley School District, the Catalina Foothills School District, the Sunnyside School District and the proposed incorporation of Vail. Vote early and avoid the lines at the polls on Election Day!

For those voters who are on the Permanent Early Voting List as well as *all registered voters* in the Altar Valley School District, your vote-by-mail ballot was mailed on Thursday, October 10th. Please allow a few days to receive your ballot before contacting our office.

For those voters in the Catalina Foothills School District, the Sunnyside School District and the proposed Town of Vail who are not on the Permanent Early Voting List, you may:

- ✓ Vote early at any of our early voting sites:
 - Recorder's Office at 115 N Church Ave. in downtown Tucson
 - Recorder's Office at 6920 E. Broadway Blvd, Suite D on the eastside of Tucson
 - Recorder's Office at 6550 S. Country Club Dr. on the southside of Tucson
- ✓ Order a vote-by-mail ballot to be sent directly to your home.

If you are not on the Permanent Early Voting List and would like to order your vote-by-mail ballot, log onto the Pima County Recorder's web site at www.recorder.pima.gov and click on the link for "Early Ballot Request," or download a request form to mail in. You may also order a ballot by phone at (520) 724-4330; out-of-towners may call the toll free number at (800) 775-7462 and ask for extension 4330. All vote-by-mail ballot requests must be received by the Recorder's office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 25, 2013.

For voters in the City of Tucson, please note that the Tucson City Clerk's office is conducting their own election. If you have any questions about your City of Tucson ballot, you need to contact them directly at 520-791-4213. They will be mailing those ballots to every registered voter in the City of Tucson on Thursday, October 17, 2013.
