



NEW FLAT RECORDING FEE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019

A new flat recording fee for any documents processed in the State of Arizona will go into effect on July 1, 2019. This fee schedule change is in accordance with [Senate Bill 1043](#) passed and signed into law in 2018. The new flat fee for recording a document in County Recorder offices throughout Arizona will be \$30.00 per transaction.

The flat recording fee now includes all of the following: Extra page counts, additional indexing categories, referring to previous recordation information, affidavit of Real Property Value fees and additional postage fees. Fees for maps per [A.R.S. §11-481.C](#) and copy fees per [A.R.S. §11-475](#) remain the same.
