Rules for the Presidential Preference Election

- **Only those voters who are registered in the Democratic Party are eligible to receive a ballot for this election.** The Arizona Republican Party has decided not to participate in the 2020 Presidential Preference Election.
- Voters who are not registered in the Democratic Party, including Independent and Party Not Designated, and who want to participate in this election can choose to change their political party to Democrat to be eligible. Visit servicearizona.com or complete a paper voter registration form and return it to our office. The cut-off date to register for new voters or for party changes is by midnight on **Tuesday, February 18, 2020.**
- Voters may change their party again after the PPE: register at servicearizona.com or complete a paper voter registration form and return it to our office.
