Deadline to Place in the Mail Your Ballots for CD8 Special Congressional Election

The deadline for the Pima County Recorder's Office to receive your vote-by-mail ballot is Election Day, Tuesday, June 12, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. If you still want to mail your ballot, F. Ann Rodriguez, the Pima County Recorder, recommends you do so no later than Friday, June 8, 2012 to ensure it reaches her office in time.

Ms. Rodriguez, would like to remind all voters **NOT** to give their voted ballots to a stranger. The only people you should trust with your voted ballot to deliver them to our office are a family member, a trusted co-worker, a friend, or the US Postal Service.

If a voter wants to hand deliver their voted ballot, they should take it to any of the Recorder's Office locations on Friday, June 8th or Monday, June 11th between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or on Election Day June 12th between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at our Downtown and Ballot Processing location only. The three Recorder's Office locations are:

Downtown	115 N Church

Ballot Processing	6550 S. County Club

In addition, if voters still have their voted early ballots on Election Day they may hand deliver them to any polling location on Election Day between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Voters may contact the Pima County Recorder's Office Voter Registration Division at 724-4330.
