### *New Online Search Available for Pima County Voters!*

The Pima County Recorder's Office has just launched a new Voter lookup option on their website. The new website option is located under Voter Information and is called "***Check Your Registration***" at [www.recorder.pima.com](http://www.recorder.pima.com). Now, Pima County Voters have to option to look up their personal voter registration details such as Political Party, Residential Address, and Precincts. Voters can also see Precinct and District details, Eligible elections, voting history and polling locations. For security purposes Voters must supply their First and Last Name, Date of Birth and either a Voter ID or Driver's License Number.
