## Last Day to Register to Vote is TODAY!

NOTE TO RADIO STATIONS: Please continue to announce this all day to your listening audience in order to get the message out.

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind voters that the deadline to register to vote in the November 6, 2012 General Election is midnight, **TODAY TUESDAY**, **OCTOBER 9, 2012**.

The Recorder's office will be conducting <u>CURBSIDE VOTER REGISTRATION</u> at two locations. The downtown office at 115 North Church Avenue will be conducting curbside registration between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 9, 2012, and the Eastside Recorder's Office at 6920 E Broadway Boulevard, Suite D will be doing curbside registration from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.

A new voter registration form must be completed by anyone who has moved (even to a new apartment number in the same complex), changed their name since their last registration, is a new Pima County resident, or would like to change their party affiliation.

Forms may be obtained at the Pima County Recorder's office, any Arizona Department of Motor Vehicle branch, all post offices and libraries, political party headquarters, and city/town halls. Voters may also log onto the Recorder's office web site at <a href="www.recorder.pima.gov">www.recorder.pima.gov</a> and download a form to complete and mail in, or click on the link called "EZVOTER" for the online

Motor Vehicle Division voter registration system. Or, voters may also log onto <u>servicearizona.com</u> to access the site directly. Please note that if you use that site, due to the large volume of voter registration changes being made on the site, make sure to save your confirmation receipt as proof.
