Avoid Crowds at Early Voting Sites

The Pima County Recorder offers Early Voting and Emergency Voting before Election Day. Early Voting begins on Wednesday, July 8, 2020, at the three County Recorder offices. Other Early Voting Sites will be open on Monday, July 27 through Friday, July 31, 2020, the week before Primary Election Day.

The Pima County Board of Supervisors approved 11 Emergency Voting Sites for the 2020 Primary and General Elections. The attached table shows the location and hours for Early Voting Sites and Emergency Voting Sites for the upcoming Primary Election.

Voters must bring appropriate identification to vote at an Early or Emergency Voting Site. The most commonly used ID is the Arizona driver's license with the voter's current residential address. The list of acceptable identification is here: https://www.recorder.pima.gov/faq_voter_electionday#k
