Public Service Announcement: Ballot Drop Box

One of our Ballot Drop Boxes was temporarily unavailable today from noon to 12:42 pm because of an excessive number of ballots dropped off by voters. We were notified of the situation by a voter and immediately deployed a bipartisan courier team to empty the ballot box. By 12:29 pm, a staff member was present to explain the situation to voters and redirect them to their nearest Ballot Replacement Site. A bipartisan courier team arrived at 12:42 pm to empty the ballot box. They were also able to accept ballots from waiting voters as they emptied the box. Each Ballot Drop Box can hold 1,600 ballots; however more than 2,600 ballots were deposited into the box.

We have created a contingency plan in case this occurs again and will implement more frequent ballot pickups and review options for installing multiple or larger ballot drop boxes, due to the popularity of this service.

We appreciate your patience as we learn how our community utilizes the newest resources that we've made available. Our office is committed to ensuring safe and secure voting options for voters.

All three Ballot Drop Boxes are currently available and will remain open until 7 pm, Tuesday November 4, 2025.

Drop Box locations:

- **Downtown Walk-Up:** Recorder's Office, 240 N. Stone – In the courtyard facing the Recorder's Office
- **Downtown Drive-Up:** Recorder's Office, 240 N. Stone – On the utility driveway between 240 N. Stone and 200 N. Stone
- **East Side Drive-Up:** Recorder's Office, 6920 E. Broadway Blvd. – At the southwest corner of the parking lot in front of the Pima County Health Department office
