

Pima County Introduces 24-Hr Ballot Drop-Off Boxes to Enhance Voter Access and Security


In a significant improvement to voter accessibility, Pima County is proud to announce the introduction of Ballot Drop Boxes that will be accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week during the election period.

This initiative enhances voter accessibility and streamlines the voting process, benefiting voters who work or other barriers to in-person voting and provides a practical and secure alternative to traditional voting methods.

Security Features:

- Located on County Property
- Under secure video
- Bolted into concrete
- Contains waterless fire extinguisher
- Anti-pry door jam
- Narrow opening for ballots only
- Industrial hinges
- One Hand chute for accessibility needs
- Sloped entry and false ledge preventing contamination or destruction and anti-theft construction
- * Additional boxes will be installed ahead of the 2026 Statewide Election.
