**Rules for the Presidential Preference Election**

- **Only those voters who are registered as either Democratic, Republican, or Green Party are eligible to receive a ballot for this election.**
- **Those voters who are registered as Independent or Party Not Designated and want to participate in this election can choose to re-register to vote as either Republican, Democratic OR Green. This can be done either at [servicearizona.com](http://servicearizona.com) or by completing a paper voter registration form and returning it to our office. This must be completed by midnight on Monday, February 22, 2016.**
- **After the Presidential Preference Election voters can change their registration back to Independent or Party Not Designated by re-registering at [servicearizona.com](http://servicearizona.com) or by completing a paper voter registration form and returning it to our office.**
